## SYSTEM SUMMARY

GENERAL APPROACH AND STYLE
Very weak preemptive and take out doubles in favorable vulnerability
5 card majors, 2 over 1 game forcing
1NT response to a major opening is almost forcing
The response to $1 \&$ maybe very weak
1NT (non-vulnerable) 10-13 otherwise 14-16(17)
$1 \%$ maybe 2 c or longer
$1 \diamond$ always 5c or 4-4-4-1 (any singleton)
Opening bids may be weaker than 11 hcp , even in 1st and 2nd
SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENSE
