

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
<b>OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)</b>
Aggressive, rarely 4 cards
Fit jumps
UCB
2NT good raise
Leaping and non-leaping Michaels, 4♣♦Forcing
<b>INT OVERCALL (2<sup>nd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Live; Responses; Reopening)</b>
15-18, responses as after opening 1NT
Reopening: 11-14 responses as over opening 1NT
<b>JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)</b>
1-suited: weak, usually 6-cards
2-suited: 2NT lowest two unbid suits but 19-20 BAL in 4th
Reopen: Intermediate – six card suit
<b>DIRECT &amp; JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)</b>
1m-2m shows Majors; 1M-2M shows other Major plus a minor
1x-3x asks for stop for NT
1x-4x shows 9+ tricks in a Major
<b>VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)</b>
2♠ is either single suited ♦ or both M
2♦ is single suited ♥ or ♠ + m
2♥ is 5♥ and 4+ m
2♠ is ♠
<b>VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)</b>
Vs WK 2 DBL is T/O then 2NT is transfer to 3♠ to play at 3 level
4m is that m 5+ and 5+M strong but not forcing
Vs WK 3 DBL is T/O, 4m is that m 5+ and 5+M strong but not F
Vs 4 level openings x is values
<b>VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♠ or 2♠</b>
Vs strong 1♠ : X both M, 1NT both m, weak jumps, 2♠ natural
<b>OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE</b>
RDBL is 9+; new suit is F1; jump in new suit is fit;
Jump raise is pre-emptive; 2NT is good raise

<b>SYSTEM SUMMARY</b>
<b>GENERAL APPROACH AND STYLE</b>
Strong NT, 5 card Majors, prepared ♠ (2+), 2♦ multi weak M or strong m, 2♥ 5+5+m weak, 2♠ 5+5+ other weak
Inverted minors, 2 over 1 forcing to 2NT or suit agreement
1♠ opener can be 2 if balanced (can include 4(3)-3(4)-4-2 type)
2♠ opener is strong
<b>SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENSE</b>
2♦ multi weak M or strong m,
2♥ 5+5+m weak, 2♠ 5+5+ other weak
<b>SPECIAL FORCING PASS SEQUENCES</b>
(INT)-DBL-(2♠ or 2♦)-PASS is F
<b>IMPORTANT NOTES</b>
After 1NT rebid then 2♠ demands 2♦
After 1NT rebid then 2♦ is GF, not natural
After 1NT rebid then 2NT demands 3♠
<b>PSYCHICS: Very rare</b>
