OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
1 st level, light: 10+HCP
Cue bid response: INV+ with FIT or GF any
NAT responses otherwise, level 1 new suit force, level 2 new suit non forcing
Reopening may be light
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
NAT (15)-18 HCP
Reopening: 11-15 HCP
System On
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Preemptive, facing passed hand wide-range
2NT unusual, lowest 2 unbid suits except reopening: 19-20 QBAL
2 suiter overcalls maximum 7 loser
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
Michaels, 2NT is ART INV+
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening; PH)
2C: Majors, at least 5-4
2D: One long major, 6+
2H/2S: 5+H/S and 4+minor
2NT: 5-5 minors
Constructive against weak NT, can be weak against strong NT
X- penalty oriented, top of notrump zone in HCP
VS. PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
T/O, Lebensohl
Cuebids ask for stopper
NTs NAT
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣
VS. 1C: X Majors, 1NT both minors, other bids are NAT, can be 4card suit at level 1
VS. 2C: Same as against 1C just on level 2
OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE
XX: 10+, penalty oriented
1M-(X)-3M PRE
1M-(X)-2NT invitation+ with 4+M
