- 2NT 5+♣ INV+ or to play in a suit below opponents suit
- 3X TRF, INV+ if TRF to OPP suit then short in OPP suit "3-suited"
- [8] **Culbertson 5NT** asks for trump honour (AKQ)/length
- 7 trump suit 2 honours
- 1 below trump suit A or K
- 2 below trump suit Q
- 3 below trump suit extra length
- [9] **Voidwood** when trump is agreed or agreeing trump
- Jump to new suit shows void and asks for aces (RKCB/1430) outside this suit
