## Proposed Defence

Double: 13-15 balanced hand or any strong hand (18+) with good suit. (double then bid) 3C/D/H/S: Natural.
3NT: To play.
4C: At least 5-5 in Majors or 6-5+ with longer heart
4D: Majors, longer spade.
4H: Minors, equal length, or longer club.
4S: Minors, longer diamond
With take out. Pass, then double as take out.
